Why register? This allows us to make sure we have enough pizza for players and siblings as well as order enough food for adults interested in the brisket meal as well as seating for all.

Even if you are not planning to eat, please register your player to ensure they get pizza. If your child is not registered, they will not be entered into the draw for a free 2026/2027 DNMH register; only players who are registered for the banquet will be entered into the draw.

Baskets/Donations: arrangement for drop off and pick up **April 20th, 2026**. Communication with the Hockey moms on times or pick up location will be shared closer to.

Questions about meal option:

- All registered DNMH players will receive a free pizza lunch.
- Siblings under 12 are also free (please select the correct meal option on the registration form)
- Bench staff (registered bench staff-on the official roster) will receive free "adult" brisket meal.
- Parents/siblings interested in the brisket meal cost is \$20.00
- If a player prefers a brisket meal, please check that off (cost is \$20) instead of the free pizza option.
- *Example:* A family of five (one player, one parent who was on the bench, another parent and 2 siblings under 12) total cost for two pizzas and two brisket meals would be \$20.00.

Medals and Awards:

U5-U8:

All players u5-u8 will receive a medal from their coach on the night of the banquet. Coaches will be asked to come to the stage/front of room and will call out their players. Players line up at the front and following all the team receiving their medals, they will move over to the photo booth area where we have a photographer who will take a group photo. Parents are welcome to take photos as well following the award ceremony; or while their player is standing at the front of the room.

U9-U18:

Coaches have been asked to choose three players for each team for the following awards: Most Improved, Most Sportsman and MVP for the season.

Each coach will be asked to come to the front of the room and call out their three players awarded this year. Once all three players have received their award they will be asked to go to the photo booth area where their photo will be taken.

Parents are welcome to take additional photos while their player is up at the front or following the award ceremony.

What to expect:

Raffle tickets for prizes and baskets (provided by teams and community sponsors) Tickets will be \$5.00 per sheet (**CASH ONLY**) -Raffles will be drawn at 6:30pm. Winners will be contacted if they are no longer in attendance (from earlier session)

A draw for all registered players in attendance will occur at 6:30pm as well for a free base registration for the 2026/2027 year.

Pizza lunch/dinner includes drink, fruit and vegetables for all registered players in attendance.

Sandbar on the beach Beef Brisket meal includes potatoes, pasta Caesar salad, bun and toppings.

Any excess proceeds from the banquet will be reinvested into our organization, supporting our ongoing efforts to provide a positive and enriching hockey experience for our young athletes.
